- Terry Husseman Account's purpose is to honor the past contributions of Mr. Terry Husseman in the field of environmental management.
- Funded with payments from penalties issued for water quality violations of the Water Pollution Control Act.

Overview (cont.)

- **Governing Laws and Rules**
 - Chapter 90.48 RCW, Water Pollution Control.
 - Chapter 90.48.390 RCW, Coastal Protection Fund-Established-Moneys credited to Use.
 - Chapter 90.48.400 RCW, Coastal Protection Fund-Disbursal of moneys from.
- Maximum award per application is \$50,000. Typically range from \$15-30K.

Ineligible Applicants

- Private individual.
 - For-Profits
 - Non-Profits

- Restore or enhance the natural environment.
- Address water quality & fish / wildlife habitat protection / enhancement.
- Be in or adjacent to waters of the state (streams, lakes, wetlands, ocean).
- Provide benefits to public resources (land or water stewardship).

Goals – Year Round Applications

Applications can be submitted at any time for:

Environmental Emergencies

- Addresses risks to the natural environment as a result of a natural or man-made disaster.

Projects of Statewide Significance

- Uses innovative approaches or technologies that could be applied in multiple watersheds throughout Washington and result in a significant improvement to the natural environment.
